- Worked on resolving SASIDs

- Piloting Tranquility

## DCSD

- Haven't DL SASIDs yet
  - 10 cases under review
- No FRL information came in
- Looking at using a district owned field to house the SASID

## DPS

- SPED reports late again from Pearson
  - May be useful for next year
- Will move to 5.0 over Christmas break and will do rollover
- Will store SASID externally and import into AltID1 using queries in JobQ
- ISIS mappings are needed to explain some internal ISIS calculations
- Citrix client is expensive to license Citrix
  - Looking at a Microsoft solution
  - Will open up one port to have the same client at home and at school
- Final deliverables with SOC and Pearson
  - Today is Alison's Duquette's last day
  - Replaced by Robert D'Arby (sp?)
- Full demo in January of Concert
