Can print extended course history on transcripts – can only pull two different score types

New reports created in JReport – DIS01j; STU96j – all contain a j at end of report designation

NCLB Briefcase – contains 4 atoms – contains Student report card for parents; AYP School and District report Cards; Teacher Staff Qualifications Reports; Graduation and Dropout Rate Report; Immigrant Funding Report; Safe Schools Reports;

AYP requires Extended test history – you identify what test scores to use
