District Sharing:

- Ft. Morgan
 - Developed some grading issues, GPA's on transcripts, report cards were all different, possibly as a result of one of the patches.
 - New Year rollover is complete.
 - There will be a position open soon, Network Administrator.
- Douglas County
 - Just keeping their heads above water.
 - Still having problems when printing from a Mac.
- Adams 12
 - Still having issues with Task Server, this will be fixed with the installation of all patches up to 6.1.3 but might recreate printing issues with the Macs.
- Brighton
 - All patched up to 6.1.3 release 2.
 - New Year roll went fine except there were a few issues with the automated 'Delete Orphan' records but after this was done manually things were fine. Kathy Green will submit a list of the Table additions created by installing the Orphan records atom to Jim, which will be posted on the web site.
 - Reviewing the 'Tabby Scheduling Software'.
- Thompson Valley
 - Reviewing the Street Validation atom for implementation. There was discussion of some of the issues when implementing this atom.
- Falcon
 - Will proceed with a New Year roll over this coming weekend.
 - They will be implementing a wireless solution district wide to be completed this summer. This will create a link of 100MB for all schools except 5 and those will have a connection of 36MB with a total of 15 connections. The WAN solution is a four ring configuration that ensures their WAN will remain operational even in the unlikely event of a multiple equipment outage or similar. There is a power point presentation available upon request. Because of having to upgrade phone equipment they will not be implementing voice over IP for a year or so.
- DPS
 - Did their New Year Roll in December.
 - They have implemented a full year calendar, which has helped clear up some enrolment issues.
 - Having problems with the 'White screen of death'. They have tried several changes but no solutions yet.
- Windsor
 - Had issues with creating a JReport and sending it out for others to use in the district. Worked with Pearson but had to come up with a work-around solution.
- Widefield
 - Also, had some grading issues but reinstalled the patches and it seemed to fix the problem.
 - Going to district wireless also, however, not implementing voice over IP for a few years.
