Business Meeting:

- Discussion with the group regarding the move from CSUG to CSIS to include all districts and student information systems. Vendors will still participate in the meetings.
- Meetings will be held the 2nd Monday of each month starting in September. The August meeting will be the 1st Monday at Adams 12. We will start paying \$25 per hour for the use of the room which will come out of the Users Group finances. The meeting will be from 8:30 am early arrives, meeting at 9:00 am and end at 11:30 am.

District Sharing:

- Windsor - on SASI 6.2 Looking at new SIS in a year or two. Rollover went well except for effective date. Is anyone having issues with the new version of JReport Designer? And What are the benefits to the 6.2 upgrade?
- Denver Public Schools – on SAS 6.1 and will do a final new year roll on the 28th of June. DPS will be converting to Infinite Campus on July 11th. This will be their 3rd conversion, paid for converting 5 years. They will keep SASI for view only for history purposes.
- Aurora – On SASI 6.1 Very busy with the EOY reporting. Their final roll will be the end of June. They will convert to Infinite Campus October 31st for Elementary and November 25th for Middle and High Schools. Will be converting 8 previous years. Now they will spend time cleaning data. The Safety and Discipline report was done with the Edulink software State Reporting.
- Brighton – Business as usual. The EOY report went to another department. Currently working with schools on end of year membership for Safety and Discipline. We will be using the State Reporting software from Edulink. Our final roll will be in 2 weeks. We will upgrade to 6.2 after the roll.
- Widefield – On SASI 6.1. The EOY report is done. Safety and Discipline report will be done on Friday, just waiting on HR for their part. We will be going live with IC on August 8th, converting 1 year. We will be moving over to ESchool Solutions for substitutes teachers on July 13th. Also implementing Tungston Learning, predictive learning software and will start elementary scheduling next year.
- Pearson – Pearson is offering a price reduction for districts wanting to migrate to CenterPoint @ 5% off times the number of years on SASI. The maintenance is at approximately 20%. The regular price is \$12.00 per student through December 31st.
- Adams 12 – On SASI 6.1. The last new year roll will be the 20th of June. Currently we are not looking at a new student system.
- Littleton – Converted over to IC in March of 05. The conversion is workable from SASI. Would like to know the due dates for the next EOY. When the window opens etc... Jim will try and find more definite dates for the next EOY.
- Adams 14 – On SASI 6.1. Their final roll will be this week. Working on Summer School. When moving those students we had several ADST errors. Moving to IC on August 1st, currently working on IC conversion.
- Ft Morgan – On SASI 6.1. CDE reports are done in another department. Will complete final roll over at the end of June. Looking at new student system possibly January or next summer.
- Thompson Valley – On SASI 6.1. Will do last roll over on the 20th of June. Will do the upgrade to SASI 6.2 in the last week of July. Staying with SASI because of all the director changes right now. Possibly looking at late 2006.
- Douglas County – On SASI 6.1. Doing final roll June 23rd. Running Summer School for the first time. There is a group meeting soon regarding a new student systems.
- Falcon – On SASI 6.2. Final roll will be the second week in July, after summer school. Looking at a new student system for possible 2006/07 implementation. New superintendent, 2 new assistant super's.

There was discussion on the number of accounts allowed at the RITS site. DPS=1, DCSC=2, Littleton=2, Brighton=2, Adams 12=1, Falcon=1. We would like to see the possibly of getting more than one account at each district. Each district passes one or two accounts around.
