District Sharing:

- Windsor – October Count is done and went well. Had a few issues because their charter school uses a different student information systems
- Adams 14 – Things are quiet.
- Brighton – October count was done but had to revisit a few minor issues. Schools bond did pass. The will build a new high school. The district is going back to voters for more money for additional new schools.
- Air Academy – Completed the update for all patches. Having problems with the Mac's now. Discussion on unlocking files. D20 is pursuing a new student information system. The board will vote on their next meeting.
- Colorado Springs Deaf & Blind School – Implemented a donation database, works really well. We switched from IGP to IGP server, having a few problems on the client side. In the process of implementing Intouch Online this week.
- Douglas County – Things are relatively quite. October count is finished. Pearson's new service pack it will be out in December.
- Pearson – Mark will send out schedules and the content list of patches and releases.
- Ft Morgan – Upgraded to 6.1.2, went well. October count is finished and will start using Intouch reporting. Using Intouch Online at the high school and it is great.
- Widefield – Submitted October count and it came back with new edit checks, had several issues. In the process of importing ACT scores to extended test history. Possible implementation of Tungston Learning. Submitted an RFP for a new student information system, waiting for responses. Will ask CDE to the January 10th meeting to discuss reporting issues.
- Aurora – Doing an import/export, is there a way to use a filter for exporting out of SASI? October count was an issue, doing another submission. Charter school brought up SASI, this helps with student info. It was a virtual school. Had some issues with the old enrolment codes and had to change to the new codes. Opening a new K-8 school for next years. Upgrading Tranquillity to Clarity for use in the fall. Also upgraded Novell to 6.5 and having major issues with SASI.
- Adams 14 – Excent is not working well. The district is writing their own SPED program. Bond/Mill did pass but a new student information system wasn't part of the plan. Staying with SASI for a few more years. Already broke ground for the new high school which is located at the corner of 128th. IGP server is up at the high school beta site, doing some testing.
- DPS – Will upgrade to 6.1.2 during Thanksgiving instead of Christmas break. During Christmas break we will do a new year roll. October count went well however another department does this report, but we often check CDE's web site to keep track of all changes.
