# One new data field will be added to the EOY header record for 2005-2006: "Primary Nighttime Residence"

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**Definition:** A temporary residence that is being used as a result of economic displacement. The residence may be either public or private. This field will apply only to students designated as homeless.

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**File Location:** Follows the Homeless field in the Header Record. Beginning Position = 149, Ending Position = 150.

00	N/A
01	Shelters
02	Doubled Up
03	Unsheltered (Cars, Parks, Campgrounds
04	Hotels/Motels

99	Unknown

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**Associated Edits:**

- Cannot be "00" if Homeless is "1" or "2"
- Must be "00" if Homeless is "0"

Entry Code

Transfer from a facility operated by the Department of Corrections or Department of Youth Corrections. Applies only to students who were incarcerated. Students entering from a detention center should be coded with a 12 or 13 entry type code.

Exit Code

21

Transfer to a facility operated by the Colorado Department of Corrections or Department of Youth Corrections.

# Senate Bill 05-091 will necessitate the introduction of four new membership base adjustment codes for students in GED programs

The Administrative Rules for SB-091 require students with exit code 17 to remain in a district's/school's graduation rate denominator unless one of the following graduation membership base adjustments is made.

Adjustments for GED Program Enrollees (Exit Type Code 17)	
71	Request for transcripts received.
72	Student received GED from an educational program not administered by the district.
73	Student received a diploma or certificate of completion from an educational program not administered by reporting district.
74	Student retrieved back into educational program administered by reporting district.

SB 05-091 also stipulates that all districts must obtain “adequate documentation of transfer” beginning in the 2005-2006 school year

Records Request - A formal request for a student's educational records. Used by the receiving school or district to request records from the district or program previously attended by the student.

Request for Confirmation of Enrollment and Attendance - For use by the originating (i.e. previously attended) school district in instances when the receiving district or program does not submit a formal request for records.

Notification of Withdrawal - To be completed by the student's parent or guardian if the student will be transferring out of the school district. Parents/guardians are not legally required to provide this information. This form can serve as official notification of transfer if the student is transferring to a home school program.

Student Follow-up Form - Used when the student's parent/guardian does not fill out a Notification of Withdrawal form. Provided for district record-keeping only and cannot be used as official documentation of transfer in the event of an audit.

The EOY Excel Template was recently modified to make it more user-friendly, adaptable, and easier to navigate.

### Significant Changes to the EOY Excel Template for 2005-2006

- a. Student's name appears in both the header and detail section.
- b. Student's grade level appears in both the detail and header section.
- c. Columns formatted to allow for leading zeros without truncating (birth dates, LASIDs, Entry Grade Level, etc)
- d. New field added to header section: Primary Nighttime Residence
- e. New entry and exit code of 21 allowed
- f. New adjustment codes of 71-74 added to accommodate GED transfer students.
- g. Microsoft Access version of EOY format will be made available

## *2006-2007 EOY Collection*

- Multiple detail records for students in grades K-6 to track mobility.
- Allow multiple school/grade/year detail records for students in grades K-12.
- Add warning “CSAP 3rd grade score was ‘unsatisfactory’ or ‘partially proficient’ but student is not listed with an ILP.”
- Remove 2nd and 3rd adjustment sections and other fields to reduce the length of the header file by at least 42 bytes.
- CDE will calculate two new mobility rates and four new “Freshman Follow-up Rates” per SB-091.

## 2007-2008 EOY Collection

- Remove CBLA 2 or More Years Growth and ILP 3rd Grade Cohort fields (draw this information directly from reported CSAP scores).
- “On-time” (4 years or less) graduation rate reporting by CDE.
- Expanded graduation and completion rates (3, 5, 6, and 7 year graduates/completers).
