District Sharing;

DPS: Are in the process of updating hardware/servers with more robust equipment.

Windsor: Looking for an enrollment form for family or separate form for students. How do others enroll?

Summit: Using Power school, things are running well. We have 2 users group one in the east and one in the west side of Colorado. Will be having a meeting next month with all, Pearson and Power school will have representatives there.

Adams 12: In the process of shopping for SIS. Finally got IGPro server up and running in all schools.

Ft Morgan: Running IC 2007.2.2, have seen no problems but having problems with Explore 7, seems they don't work well together. Try updating Adobe or Java.

Adams 14: Working towards upgrading to 2007

Widefield: Will do an upgrade over spring break. End of year report not working well but using work around.

CIC: Mark Richardson is checking on what will be in the new release of IC. Not all upgrades contain past upgrades applications/patches/releases. When requesting upgrades you must request all previous patches/hot fixes/1 off's for Colorado. These need to be installed in 'all' your databases if you are running more than 1 instance of IC database.

Littleton: They are on 2006.3.1 will be doing an upgrade over spring break. Will be bringing up Standard Based reports cards.

CBOCES: On IC 2007.2 and have 11 districts. Using the Food service piece and having issues with the POS. Services side is working well but the other side is not.

Eaton: IC 2007.2.1 How do we get new codes? Need to upgrade to 2.2. Posting to transcripts is Duplicating, posting twice. The fix is installing the transcript patch.

Douglas County: Running into performance issues, still exploring the cause. Online registration was going to previous years and requests were posting as alternates. Found the issue and created documentation and will send out to the group.

Boulder: Working on state reporting. Will be installing new server and using old server for replication. Will run reports, ect on the old server to free up memory on new server.

Jeffco: Having issues with year long classes, when student drops year long class this still shows up in progress. Fix is you have to 'end date' in enrollment for this class. Going to roll out Messenger.

Aurora: IC 2006.3 Considering hosting SQL training will notify when date is set.

Brighton: Went live January 8th. Things going well, hired temps to input data for emergency info. Still cleaning up households. Grad planner has some issues and requires a lot of planning. Running report cards seems to tie up sis. Create a schedule per school to run these. Also, clear up temp files every night and this will help with Java errors.
