- **Board Elections**

- **District Sharing**

- Littleton – we are having issues with system going down, this is happening 3-4 times per day. The nic card was disabling and we would have to manually reset. The new DB server is set at 64 bit AWE box has to be checked marked, this must be done because the box will run out of memory. We are upgrading over break because of the race/ethnicity. How is Campus handling the habitually truant issue?
- Centennial BOCES – We will be skipping the upgrade to 2009.2 and will go with 2010 this summer or when available.
- Aurora – Standard base grading is going live this fall. We will pilot the elementary schools first. Campus is offering the Product Knowledge test a \$200 test out package. 1 month to test out. We are wondering what version this test will be given on. We are looking at a demo for Enrich RTI system and will the company will customize for each district; there is a sped piece also.
- Greeley – we are finally up on Campus but having issue with transcripts and the graduation date. The graduation date is a bug in campus and will not print graduation date. Campus is aware of the issue and plans a patch soon.
- Douglas – Upgraded to SQL server 2005 this past weekend. We are running in 64 bit capable mode which is not support but seems to be running fine. Running 2000 in 64 bit we were having issue with performance.
- Boulder – Rolled out new student enrollment records system. It is going very well and it imports to Campus with a push of a button. We are using Visual Studio on the front end and ASP to move to Campus. We will upgrade over spring break. We are going to be demoing Exceed RTI product now but there is a lot of set up work for RTI.
- Jeffco – We are finalizing our Oct count audit. There are no tools available online for database exceptions and resolutions; we would like to start one. We could link this to the CSIS web site. It would be valuable to all districts. There is an EDAC website, this link needs to be put on the CSIS web site.
- Thompson – Upgrading over the summer, mainly for the use of ShoutPoint.
- Eaton – Things are working well, had a couple of security issues we had to rethink how we set up security.
- Academy – We are having server issues, we will be receiving a new server but will not set up til this summer. We implemented our online enrollment which goes directly into Campus. It was written with Oracle (APEX) things are going smoothly. We are going to implement a texting system and Payschools for online payments.
- Adams – Going live in Aug of 09. Currently having district training. We did our own conversion and this is going well.
- Widefield – We use email massager frequently. We also check the reports for bounced email addresses; Campus is not listing all bounced addresses. We have set up the data warehouse

on a separate server. Cube Builder is now not working correctly, we believe the data bases have to be on the same server.

- Jeffco – We have not decided when to upgrade. We are having problems with Internet Explorer 8, parents cannot log into the portal. IE 8 is still in beta testing.
- Brighton – Things are going smoothly. Just implemented kinder report card, everyone seems to like it. Our enrollment forms are finally done.
- Falcon – Things are going pretty smooth. We had a few hiccups in grades/transcripts because of the conversion but things have been fixed. We are bringing SPED on board now and this is just starting. We also will be upgrading to SQL server 05.
- DPS – We have brought up Schoolnet for reporting services. We run a reporting script for running report cards. We have changed the way we do new patches/upgrades to Campus. We send out a spreadsheet and scripts for our customers to sign off on testing @ the school site for their current job function. These are then sent back to IT and schools will then own the upgrade/patch.
- May User Day – May 11th, the location has been changed to Aurora School District in the main conference room. A notice will be sent out with a map to the list serve. We will have CDE and Infinite Campus 2010. If you have topics of discussion for CDE please submit to Jim Anderson and he will pass these on to CDE.
- There is discuss on changing the CSIS monthly meeting location to another district for next year. The board will post this information as soon as a decision has been made.
