Test Setup – Proficiency Levels

Campus 2010.1 now allows districts and schools to establish *Proficiency Levels* that can be utilized in multiple tests during import. Proficiency Levels are the state defined 'result' on a state assessment, based on a student test score. Each assessment type may be assigned different proficiency levels.

Test Setup – Achievement Standards

Achievement Standards are the state defined range, or cut scores, that determine the proficiency level to be associated with a student's test scores. Achievement standards may be linked to a particular subject area, year, or level of assessment.

Note: Scores listed in this presentation DO NOT necessarily represent actual CDE Achievement Standards. Care should be taken to get this information from your assessment coordinator on an annual basis.

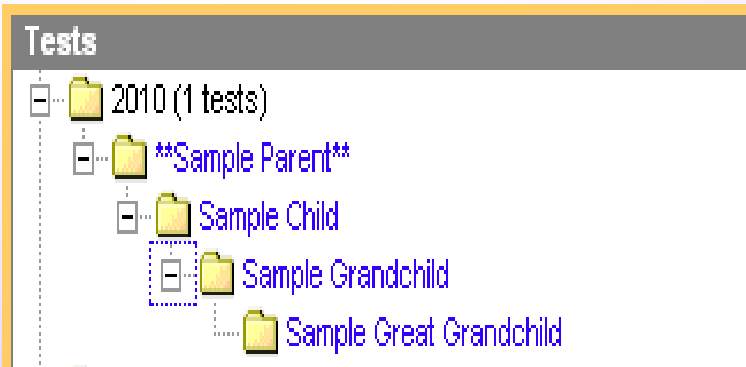

Score Import Wizard – New options

- New in 2010.1, you have the option of indicating whether your source data has a Header row. If the data does include header information, checking this box will help eliminate errors when you import data.
- Also new in 2010.1, you have the option of importing data into a single school, or multiple schools. If 'One District, One School' is selected, you will need to indicate which school you will import. If 'One District, Multiple Schools' is selected, the School Tested drop down will not appear.

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Score Import Wizard – New options

- When mapping to Achievement Standards (previously set up under Sys Admin > Assessment > Proficiency – Achievement Standards) you will select the last field in the Parent record, 'Score.acctProfLevelItemID' using the import action of 'Calculate value using grading scale'. This option will read the student scores and convert them to the Academic Achievement standards.
- **Note:** Currently the Academic Achievement Standards only translate at the parent test level.
